## *Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017*

### **Exemption Notice**

#### **Exemption No: ECP-23-0003E**

I, Tracy Gurnett, a Delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (the Department) grant this exemption from Part 3 of the Product Emissions Standards Act to STIHL Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 76004881145).

This exemption is granted under Section 32 of the Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017 in accordance with exemption category 30 (1)(b) for the testing, evaluation or display for the emissions-controlled products specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

This exemption comes into force on the date that it is published on the Department's Website.

This exemption expires on the date specified in Condition 1 of Schedule 2.

In accordance with paragraph 32(1)(a) of the Rules, notice of this exemption will be published on the Department's website.

## Schedule 1

## Schedule 2

### Exemption Conditions

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In accordance with subsection 34(2) of the *Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017*, the exemption for the engines specified in Schedule 1 is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The import, testing and evaluation of the ECPs must be completed prior to the expiry date of 31 October 2024.
2. Upon arrival, the ECPs must be securely stored on STIHL Australia Pty Ltd premises and marked in such a manner that they are clearly identifiable as ECPs imported under this exemption.
3. A copy of this exemption must be clearly displayed in the area(s) of the premises where the ECPs are stored.
4. STIHL Australia Pty Ltd must submit a comprehensive report demonstrating compliance with the conditions of this exemption prior to 31 October 2024.
5. When the ECPs have been utilised for the purpose of this exemption and are no longer required, they must be re-exported or destroyed prior to the expiry date of this exemption, as follows:
  - a. destroyed through a product destruction service and a certificate of destruction collected as evidence of the destruction and provided to the Department prior to 31 October 2024, or
  - b. exported and a record of the export collected as evidence provided to the Department prior to 31 October 2024.
6. Any STIHL Australia staff or external testing agents engaged to undertake the required testing of the ECPs must be made aware of the requirements and limitations of this exemption.
7. This exemption is for a total of ten (10) ECPs as described in Schedule 1.
