When to use this form

Organisations listed on the Register of Environmental Organisations (REO) are required to submit statistical information to the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water on an annual basis. This requires your organisation to submit this form for the 2022 reporting period.

Failure to provide information requested by the department in this form may result in the commencement of compliance action which could lead to your organisation being removed from the REO. Any action taken by the department in this regard will be in accordance with the REO Guidelines and relevant legislation, including the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 (Cth) (the Act).

To avoid delays in reporting, your organisation is not required to submit a copy of the audited financial statement with the statistical return. However, the department may request supplementary information, including an audited financial statement, as part of its assurance process.

This form must be completed by a person authorised by your organisation to act on its behalf. To complete this form:

- download a copy of the form to your computer and check that you can save information in the form.
- complete ALL boxes either by placing an X in applicable boxes or typing directly into the form. An X may be placed in the applicable box by double clicking on the box and selecting 'checked'.
