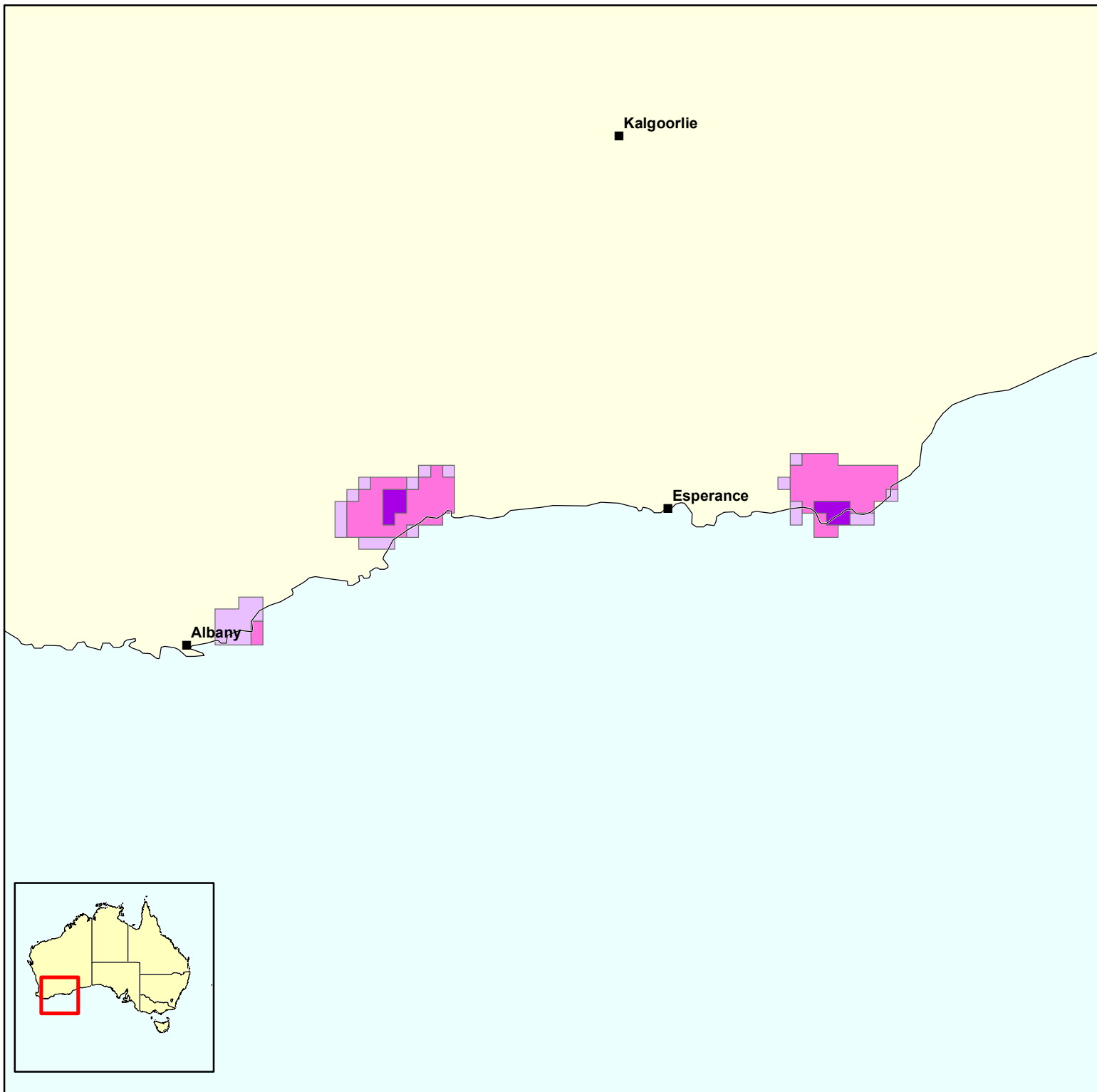


Distribution of the critically endangered western ground parrot, kyloring (*Pezoporus flaviventris*)

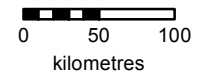
This distribution map is based on observation points provided by WA Naturmap (DPaW) and experts (TSSC, March 2011). The known distribution was determined by buffering validated points by 5 km. The likely distribution represents native vegetation types coincident with observation points and habitat for the parrot, buffered by 1 km. The possible distribution represents the soil and geology types coincident with the likely and known distributions, buffered by 5 km. Distribution has been generalised to 10 km. Distribution created by ERIN October, 2011.
