**Revocation of Accreditation of a Plan, Regime or Policy for the purposes of Part 13
Accreditation of a Plan, Regime or Policy for the purposes of Part 13**

I, JOANNE BEATH, A/gAssistant Secretary, Wildlife Trade and Biosecurity Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment:

- a) revoke, under subsection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, the accreditation of the management regime for the New South Wales Ocean Trawl Fishery dated 2 February 2010, and
- b) being satisfied that:
 - i) the management regime for the New South Wales Ocean Trawl Fishery, in force under the New South Wales *Fisheries Management Act 1994* and the New South Wales Fisheries Management Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006, requires persons engaged in fishing under the management regime to take all reasonable steps to ensure that members of listed threatened species, listed migratory species, cetaceans and listed marine species are not killed or injured as a result of the fishing, and
 - ii) the fishery to which the management regime relates does not, or is not likely to, adversely affect:
 - a) the survival or recovery in nature of any listed threatened species, or
 - b) the conservation status of a listed migratory species, cetacean, or listed marine species or a population of that species,

accredit the management regime for the New South Wales Ocean Trawl Fishery in force under the New South Wales *Fisheries Management Act 1994* and the New South Wales Fisheries Management Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006 under sections 208A, 222A, 245 and 265 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) for the purposes of Divisions 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively of Part 13 of the EPBC Act.
