



Questions and answers from Webinar session held on 7 April 2014

Have specific locations been identified for delivery of projects under the Green Army Programme?

Tenderers are referred to section 2.6.1 of the Request for Tender. The Department of the Environment aims to have a wide geographic spread of Projects. Service Provider(s) may be responsible for managing Teams in Projects located in regional and remote areas and/or near culturally significant sites.

How many teams are expected to participate in a project over the 2014 - 2017 funding period?

Tenderers are referred to section 2.3.2 of the Request for Tender. It is intended that a national total of 1500 Projects will be available in the Programme over the period of the Deed of Standing Offer (2014 – 2017).

Is additional funding available for Project Sponsors?

No cash funding will be provided to Project Sponsors.

Section 2.13.1 of the Request for Tender provides information on the costs that are the responsibility of the Service Provider. Within the Project Fee, and where specified in an Order, Service Provider(s) must provide consumable Project-Specific Materials to the value specified in an Order in addition to basic equipment. Project-Specific Materials will have an average value of \$10,000 per Project undertaken by the Service Provider, and must support delivery of Projects.

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Is the allowance per hr or per week?

Table 2 in section 2.5.8 of the Request for Tender sets out the hourly Participant Allowance that Service Providers must pay to Participants. Section 9.3 of the Programme Guidelines provides additional detail regarding the Participant Allowance.

Service Provider(s) are responsible for making all Allowance payments to Participants based on their attendance fortnightly in arrears.

Will the same level of funding apply to projects in remote areas?

All Service Providers will receive a Project Fee of \$192,500 (inclusive of GST), regardless of the duration or location of the Project. Tenderers are referred to section 2.13.2 of the Request for Tender for information on service fees.

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If a provider intends to subcontract the training to a range of RTOs is it necessary to list the details of all of these in the tender response, given these may not be known at this stage, depending on the projects approved?

Tenderers are referred to section 3.7.2 of the Request for Tender for details of sub-contracting arrangements.

If a tenderer wishes to engage a subcontractor to perform part or all of the Services, the tenderer should provide as much detail as possible in its tender, noting that the tenderer will not be able to use any subcontractor for the provision of the Services unless the subcontractor has been approved by the Commonwealth.
