The specimen, or the fish or invertebrate from which it is derived, was taken lawfully. Included on the list until 12/11/2009.
Specimens that are or are derived from fish or invertebrates, other than specimens that belong to species listed under Part 13 of the EPBC Act, taken in the Queensland Mud Crab Fishery, as defined in the management regime in force under the Queensland <i>Fisheries Act 1994</i> and the Queensland <i>Fisheries Regulation 1995</i> .	The specimen, or the fish or invertebrate from which it is derived, was taken lawfully. Included on the list until 24/8/2012.
Specimens that are or are derived from fish or invertebrates, other than specimens that belong to species listed under Part 13 of the EPBC Act, taken in the Queensland Spanner Crab Fishery, as defined in the regime made under the <i>Fisheries (Spanner Crab) Management Plan 1999</i> and the Queensland <i>Fisheries Regulation 1995</i> in force under the <i>Fisheries Act 1994</i> .	The specimen, or the fish or invertebrate from which it is derived, was taken lawfully. Included on the list until 5/2/2012.
