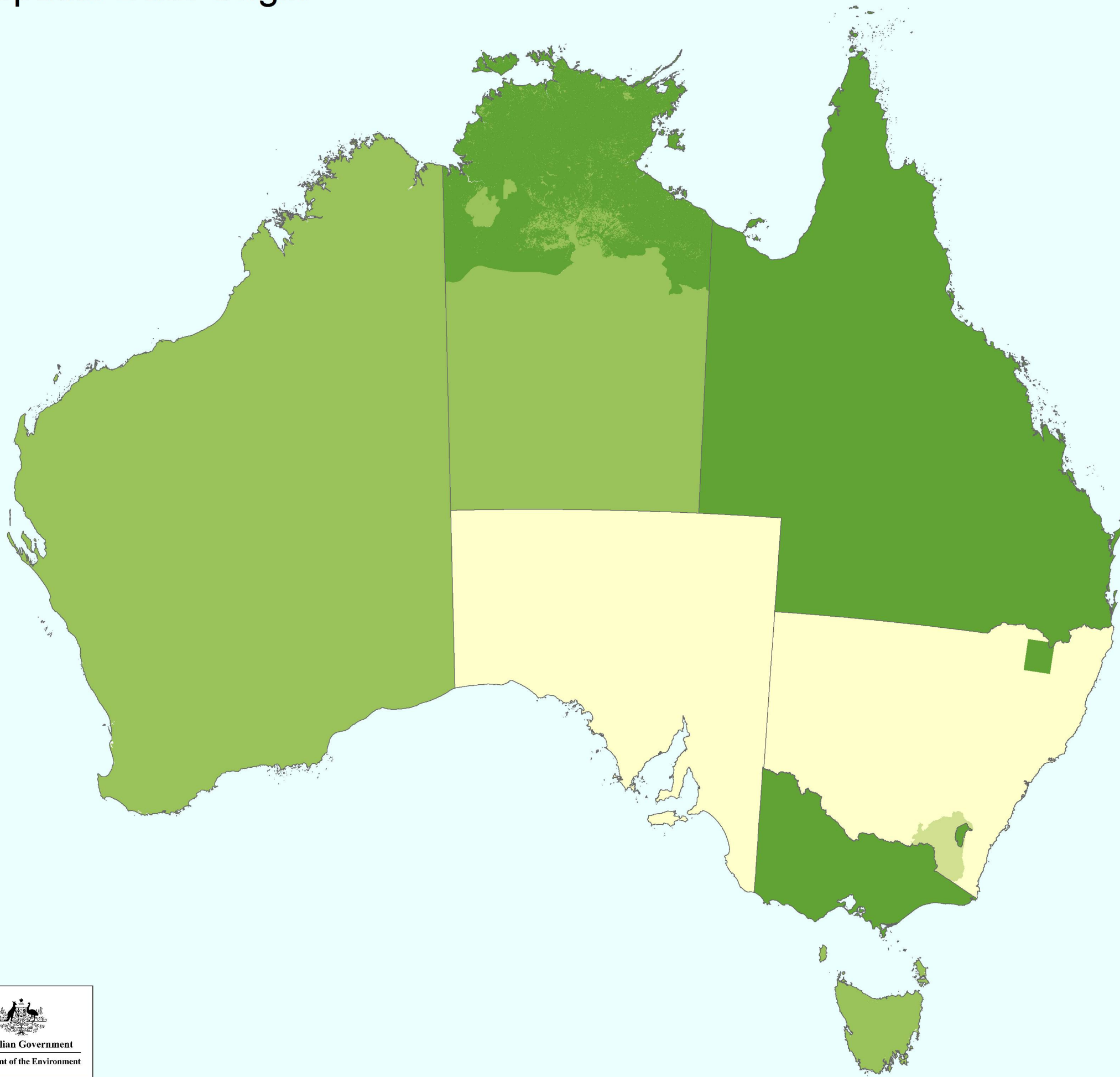
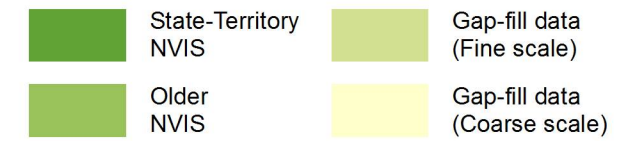

This map reflects the various sources of spatial data compiled for the National Vegetation Information System (NVIS) Version 4.2 Estimated Pre-1750 Vegetation.

Current state and territory NVIS data are the preferred source. Older NVIS data are sometimes used where a state or territory have not provided data for a new version. Gap-filling is usually carried out by the Commonwealth as a temporary solution where there are no NVIS data available, for example, Pre-1750 data are modelled by DoE for NSW and SA.

The NVIS is an ongoing collaborative initiative and future improvements to the NVIS database are planned.
