Amendment of List of Exempt Native Specimens

I, CLAIRE HOWLETT, Acting Assistant Secretary, Marine Biodiversity Policy Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and the Arts pursuant to subsection 303DC(1) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), hereby amend the list of exempt native specimens established under section 303DB of the EPBC Act by including in the list the following:

- specimens that are or are derived from fish or invertebrates, other than specimens that belong to species listed under Part 13 of the EPBC Act, taken in the Northern Prawn Fishery, as defined in the management regime in force under the *Northern Prawn Fishery Management Plan 1995*, made under the *Fisheries Management Act 1991*.

with a notation that inclusion of the specimens in the list is subject to the following restrictions or conditions:

- the specimen, or the fish or invertebrate from which it is derived, was taken lawfully; and
- the specimens are included on the list until 9 January 2014.

For the purposes of section 12(1) of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*, the specified day for the purposes of the commencement of this instrument is 9 January 2009.
